The Defence Threat Reduction Agency (DTAR), Cooperative Threat Reduction Directorate (CT), announces its intention to compete a requirement for Advisory and Assistance Services (A&AS).

The DTRA mission is to safeguard America and its allies from weapons of mass destruction (chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and high yield explosives) by providing capabilities to reduce, eliminate and counter the threat, and mitigate its effects. The mission of the CT program is to prevent the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction (WMD) and related materials, technologies and expertise from former Soviet Union (FSU) states. This includes providing for the safe destruction of Soviet era WMD, associated delivery systems and related infrastructure. The CT objectives are

- Dismantle threat WMD and associated infrastructure;
- Consolidate and secure threat WMD and related technology and materials;
- Increase transparency and encourage higher standards of conduct;
- Support defence and military cooperation with the objective of preventing proliferation,
- Synchronize CTR activities with related U.S. Government and allied programs

The purpose of this acquisition is to obtain professional advisory, management, and operational services necessary to support CT in its Cooperative Threat Reduction Program and associated mission areas.
